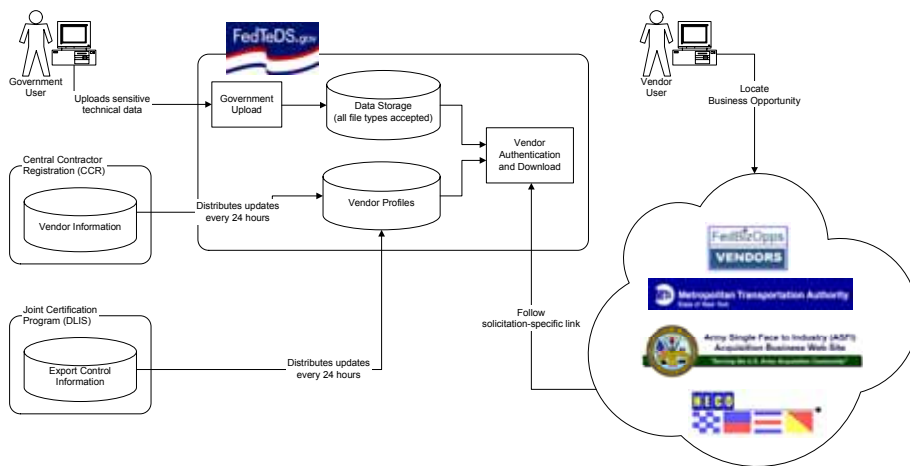
What is FedTeDS?

- **Fed**ederal **Te**chnical **D**ata **S**olutions → FedTeDS
- Web-based document distribution tool for sensitive but unclassified acquisition-related material
- Part of the Integrated Acquisition Environment (IAE) – one of the Federal E-Gov initiatives

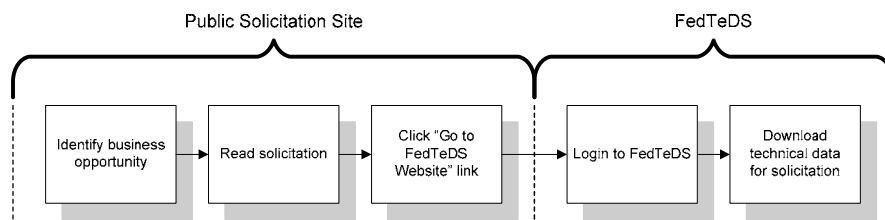

FedTeDS System Overview



How do Vendors get data from FedTeDS?

- Vendors locate business opportunities as usual (e.g., FedBizOpps)
- A link posted with the business opportunity directs Vendors to a specific page on FedTeDS for the data
- Registered Vendor Users login to FedTeDS and can download data for that business opportunity
- Vendor Users **cannot** search FedTeDS for business opportunities or data; they must navigate to FedTeDS by way of a link posted with the public solicitation notice



Integration with FedBizOpps.gov



- On FedBizOpps, under **Technical Data Package (TDP)**, there will now be a link directing Vendors to FedTeDS


Forgot Your Password? Register with FedTeDS

- Only registered Vendor Users can access data
- Vendor User registration requires:
 - Marketing Partner Identification Number (MPIN)
 - CAGE Code **or** DUNS Number

Vendor Registration

- Vendors must provide the following information to create an account on FedTeDS:
 - Central Contractor Registration (CCR) Marketing Partner Identification Number (The MPIN is a personal code created within a company's CCR profile and is used to authenticate vendors throughout E-GOV programs such as FedTeDS, Grants.gov, ORCA and PPIRS.)
 - DUNS Number or CAGE Code
 - Telephone Number
 - E-Mail Address
- New CCR registrations take approximately 48 business hours to become available in FedTeDS
- Upon successful registration, Vendor User accounts are effective immediately

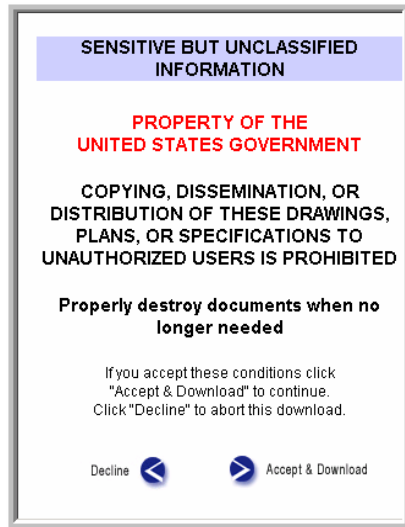
Vendor Download

After logging into FedTeDS, Vendor Users will see a list of all files for the solicitation if they have the appropriate level of access.

Vendor Download (continued)



- Vendor Users must accept a security agreement before downloading each file
- FedTeDS can distribute files in any format; however, it is the Vendor User's responsibility to obtain the appropriate application to view the files (Adobe Acrobat, WinZip, etc).

Multiple Levels of Control

Solicitation information distributed through FedTeDS may require additional levels of control used to regulate access by Vendor Users.

Export Controlled

- Requires a FedTeDS username and password
- Vendor User's company must be certified by the DLIS Joint Certification Program to receive unclassified technical data disclosing military critical technology with military or space application
- Used primarily by the United States Army, Department of the Navy, and United States Air Force

Explicit Access

- Requires a FedTeDS username and password
- Vendor Users must be granted access on an individual basis by the Government User

Export Controlled

When an unauthorized vendor attempts to access "Export Controlled" data on FedTeDS, they will see the message below.



To download documents that are designated as "Export Controlled," vendors must be certified as a U.S. or Canadian contractor by the Joint Certification Program (JCP) administered by the Defense Logistic Information Service (DLIS). To apply for this certification, vendors must submit form DD2345 (available via the "Help" link in the FedTeDS toolbar). Instructions for completing the form are on the form itself.

Explicit Access

When a Vendor User logs in to a solicitation that has been marked as Explicit Access, they are not able to download files until they have been approved for access by the Government User.

A Vendor User can request access by using the "Request Explicit Access" link provided on the solicitation page.



Explicit Access (continued)

When a Vendor User requests Explicit Access to a solicitation, FedTeDS sends an e-mail notification to the Government User.

If the request is approved, the Vendor User is notified via email. In addition, the Vendor User can now access that solicitation's information via the "My Technical Data" link located in the left-hand navigation menu.



If a Vendor User's request for access is rejected, the Government User is required to provide a reason for the rejection. The reason will be included in the email notification that is automatically sent to the Vendor User.
